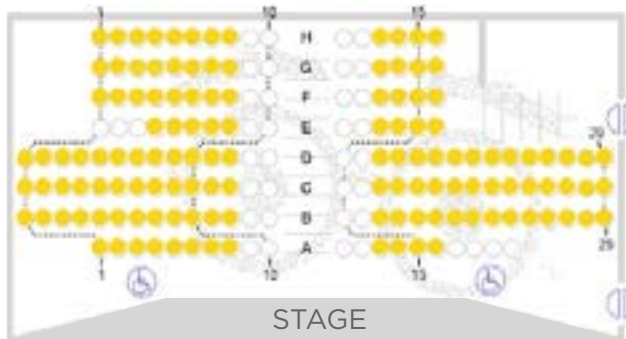

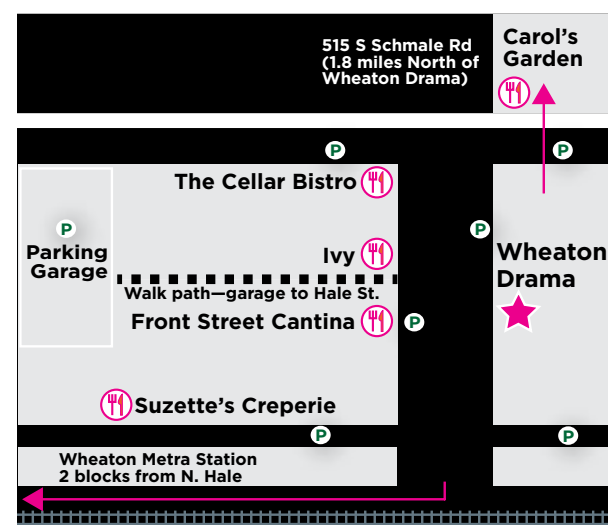

Jane Austen's heartwarming tale of romance, deceit, perseverance and siblings' devotion comes to the Wheaton Drama stage. The Dashwood sisters, displaced from their opulent home, move into a farmstead cottage and seek loving husbands in 1790s England. Wheaton Drama veteran Randall W. Knott will direct this production, having previously staged *And Then There Were None* and *Play It Again, Sam* at Playhouse 111.
